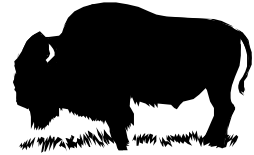




# Buffalo Ranching Seminar

Saturday, June 28<sup>th</sup>, 2008



This seminar is designed to help folks be more successful raising buffalo. It will be a day packed full of information to help serious buffalo producers better learn:

- Grass management 101 ([HMI](#) based)
- Genetic selection basics
- Buffalo fencing and corrals
- How to maximize returns from your herd

- Maximum of 15 to keep the instruction more personal

This seminar will benefit existing buffalo growers and those who are *serious* about starting new enterprises. As the buffalo business matures there are great opportunities for those who are ready to grow with it. Come and learn.
